Comparison Table Traditional Kettles v JVD Royce Hot Water Dispenser



Traditional Kettles

Take on average 5-6 minutes to boil

Delayed customer satisfaction

Consumes up to 60X more power to boil than a Royce Hot Water Dispenser

Susceptible to guest misusing kettles for other purposes like cooking instant noodles, boiling milk and coffee

Takes on average 3-4 times more water to wash and clean the whole kettle depending on state of kettle

Descaling on average once a week depending on condition of inner kettle body

JVD Royce Hot Water Dispenser

Takes on average 5 seconds to boil. 3 seconds for refill

Instant customer satisfaction

Consumes up to 60X LESS power to boil than traditional kettles

Only dispenses clean water.
More hygienic for guests

Water tank is usually in a clean state so consumes much less water for a quick rinse

Recommended to use descaling liquid once every 2-3 months
